

Gaia Pupillo is a researcher at the Legnaro National Laboratories of the Italian National Institute of Nuclear Physics. She is responsible of the "Radioisotope Service for Medicine and Applied Physics", and she is working in the field or medical radionuclides production using accelerators, in particular in the LARAMED project. Her research interest is focused on cross section measurements of unexplored nuclear reactions, to find out possible new production routes for emerging radionuclides, with particular attention to the theranostic ones or pairs.
