

Prof. Rosa Vlastou-Zanni (NTUA, Athens, Greece) received the Bachelor's degree in Physics from the University of Athens (1974) and the PhD in Nuclear Physics from the University of Birmingham (1978). She joined the National Technical University of Athens in 1980, where she is currently Emeritus Professor. She was elected as Head of the Physics Department of NTUA and she has been a member of the university board for several years. She has been a visiting scientist in many European Laboratories and Universities and has participated in several European projects (ESSA-30, EUROGAM, EUROBALL) and currently at CERN (n-TOF). Her research activities are focused on Nuclear Structure, Nuclear Reactions, Applications of Nuclear Techniques and Neutron Physics. She has supervised 17 PhD theses and many MSc and Diploma theses. She has been a member of the Organizing Committees of 8 International and 3 Hellenic Nuclear Physics Conferences. Her record includes over 240 publications in scientific journals and over 500 papers in conference proceedings.
