



Dr. Sotirios Charisopoulos (IAEA) holds a PhD in Nuclear Physics from the University of Cologne, Germany. He has more than 30 years of research experience in Nuclear Physics and its applications with particle accelerators. From 2014 to 2017, he was the Director of the Institute of Nuclear and Particle Physics of the Research Centre "Demokritos", Athens, Greece, and Head of its Tandem accelerator laboratory. He has been coordinator of various European nuclear physics networks and national delegate in research policy bodies and expert committees, including NuPECC, and chair of many international conferences and program advisory committees of accelerator laboratories. He was granted more than 6 M€ as coordinator of competitive projects aiming at establishing or upgrading accelerator infrastructures. He is the author of more than 180 articles in scientific journals and conference proceedings. In his current position as Senior Nuclear Physicist at the IAEA, he focuses on accelerator technologies and their applications with societal and economic importance.
