



**Dr. Siti Aiasah Hashim** started her career as a researcher in 1990, entering the top management office in 2017 and finally became the first woman to hold the post of Director General of Malaysia Nuclear Agency in 2020. She obtained her PhD in Applied Physics (air pollution control using plasma and electron beam technologies) in 2015 from the University of Malaya, Malaysia. She has more than 25 years' experience operating and managing Nuklear Malaysia's electron beam irradiation facility. The facility is the first one in Malaysia that offers irradiation service to the local small industries. Her main area of research is in accelerator development and application. She is also a registered Professional Technologist for Nuclear and Radiological field under the Malaysian Board of Technologist and the current President of Women in Nuclear (Malaysian Chapter). She retired in January 2022 but still active in promoting nuclear technology through academic and public engagements.
