It pools resources from the stakeholders and coordinates their efforts to invest in research, innovation and the deployment of a world-leading HPC infrastructure in Europe. The EuroHPC JU seeks to provide computing capacity, improve cooperation in advanced scientific research, boost industrial competitiveness, and ensure European technological and digital autonomy. The EuroHPC infrastructure, which includes some of the largest supercomputers in the world, is available to researchers for open research and development. Moreover, the EuroHPC JU launches open calls for proposals to fund research, innovation and training in HPC.
