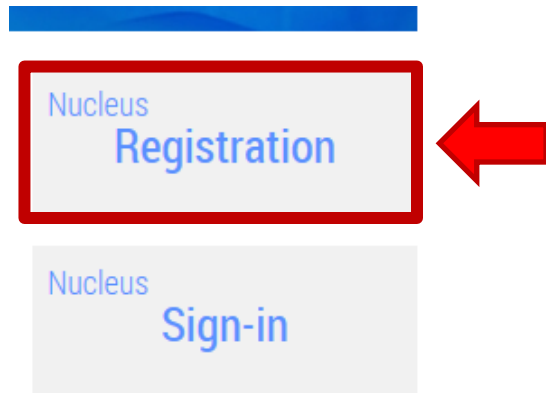

Creating a Nucleus account

- Go to nucleus.iaea.org
- Click on the ‘Nucleus registration’ in the right part of the page



- Complete the registration form by entering all the required fields. Required fields are indicated with an asterisk (*). The email address you enter on this form must be a valid address that is owned by you.

Creating a Nucleus account

- Enter a valid password
- Confirm that you have read and agreed to the Terms of Use by clicking the I accept button.

A confirmation message has been sent to your registered email address. Please follow the instructions in the email to activate your account. Once you have activated your account, you will be able to sign in to NUCLEUS.

- Open the email with subject line: IAEA NUCLEUS Account Created. The sender will be `DO_NOT_REPLY@iaea.org`.
- If you do not find the email in your inbox, please check your spam or junk mail folders.
- Click on the "Click here to activate" link in the email.



Activating your Nucleus account

- A new browser window or tab will open. If the link does not work, copy and paste the activation URL from the email into your browser's address bar.
- Your NUCLEUS Account will be activated and you will now be able to sign in to NUCLEUS using the username and password entered in the NUCLEUS Registration form. After successful activation of your account the following message will be displayed:



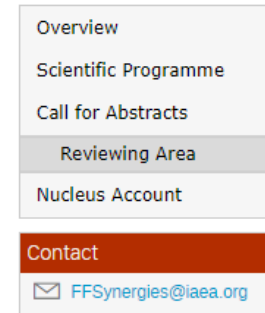

- If **marked as duplicate** or **merged**, we give the corresponding abstract title or #id




The current abstract will be merged into the selected one
