



FAQs for “Paper Presentations”

- **In what format and setting will I be delivering my presentation?**

If your paper was accepted as a “paper presentation,” then you will be presenting your completed work as part of a panel during one of ICONS’ technical sessions. These panels are typically composed of one panel “chair” and around 6 individuals who will each be granted an opportunity to present. Once all presentations are complete, the floor will be opened for Q&A and discussion.

- **Does the Secretariat provide a template for PowerPoint presentations?**

Yes, there is a PowerPoint template provided on the INDICO homepage. We strongly encourage all presenters to utilize this standardized format.

- **What is the expected duration of the presentations?**

Presenters will be allocated no more than 10 minutes to present their paper. Most technical sessions are composed of 6 individuals who will each give presentations over the course of their assigned 90-minute session. This allows for approximately 60 mins of presentations and 30 mins of Q&A/Discussion.

Session chairs reserve the right to ask you to wrap up your presentation if you run over your limit. This is to allow for sufficient time for Q&A/Discussion.

Individuals on panels with more than 6 individuals may be asked to present their work in less than 10 minutes.

Please be respectful of other presenters and stick to your allocated time.

- **Can two authors present on the same paper?**

No, only one author per paper will be allowed on the stage to present.

- **Where can I find the technical session on which I will be presenting my paper?**
