This is the 3rd and final circular of the 7th International Workshop on Compound-Nuclear Reactions and Related Topics, which will be held from 8 to 12 July 2024 at the International Atomic Energy Agency, Vienna International Centre, Vienna, Austria.

Workshop Agenda

The workshop is going to be held in Boardroom A, 2nd floor, M Building. The agenda is available on the event website (https://conferences.iaea.org/event/368/).

The workshop starts at 8:30 am on Monday and ends at 12:35 pm on Friday. Participants are advised to arrive at Checkpoint 1/Gate 1 of the Vienna International Centre (VIC) at least 30 minutes before the start of the event on the first day, to allow sufficient time for security screening and collection of the grounds pass.

Oral presentations include keynote talks (40'+10'), invited oral (25'+5'), and oral contributions (12'+3'), covering all the topics of the workshop. A special session in memoriam of Eric Bauge and his lifetime work will be held on Thursday afternoon, organised jointly with CEA Bruyères.

A poster session will be held on Tuesday at 5:30 pm, in the exhibition area in front of the meeting room, Boardroom A. Presenters will have the opportunity to discuss their work with other participants and answer questions.

The reception will take place in the same area starting after the poster session at 6:30 pm. It serves as a platform for further discussions with presenters while enjoying a light buffet and refreshments.

Contributions

All submitted abstracts are available online in <u>Contributions</u> and will also be included in a more compact Book of Abstracts that will be accessible from the website before the workshop starts.

Presentations

Oral presenters are requested to upload their slides to the website <u>at least one day before their</u> presentation is scheduled.

Presentation format: PPT or PDF.



Posters

Posters will be mounted on the poster stands on <u>Monday morning</u> (each individual stand will be marked with the ID number of the submitted abstract) and will remain in display throughout the week. They will be removed by noon on Friday the latest.

Poster dimensions: A0 size (84.1 cm x 118.9 cm; 33.1 inches x 46.8 inches).

Conference service staff will be available to help with mounting and removing the posters.

Coffee and Lunch Breaks

Although we are not charging a registration fee for this event, we will provide complimentary coffee breaks in the morning and afternoon with coffee, tea, and pastries, as well as a Reception with a light buffet and refreshments on Tuesday evening following the poster session.

Lunch will be available at the Cafeteria of the Vienna International Centre <u>at participants' own expense</u>. The cafeteria offers international cuisine with a variety of meals, including a salad bar, desserts, and refreshments, all at reasonable prices.

The workshop proceedings will be published online in the EPJ Web of Conferences. All published contributions will be available online as open access. A peer-review will be organized for all submitted articles, including keynote, invited, oral, and poster presentations, in accordance with the journal's policies.

Keynote oral presentations: 8 pages Invited oral presentations: 5 pages Contributed oral presentations: 4 pages

Poster presentations: 3 pages

All articles must be submitted through the workshop website. Participants are requested to submit both the source files (LaTeX or MS Word, along with auxiliary bib files) and PDFs.

Templates:

A4 (210 x 297 mm) paper size, two columns format.
