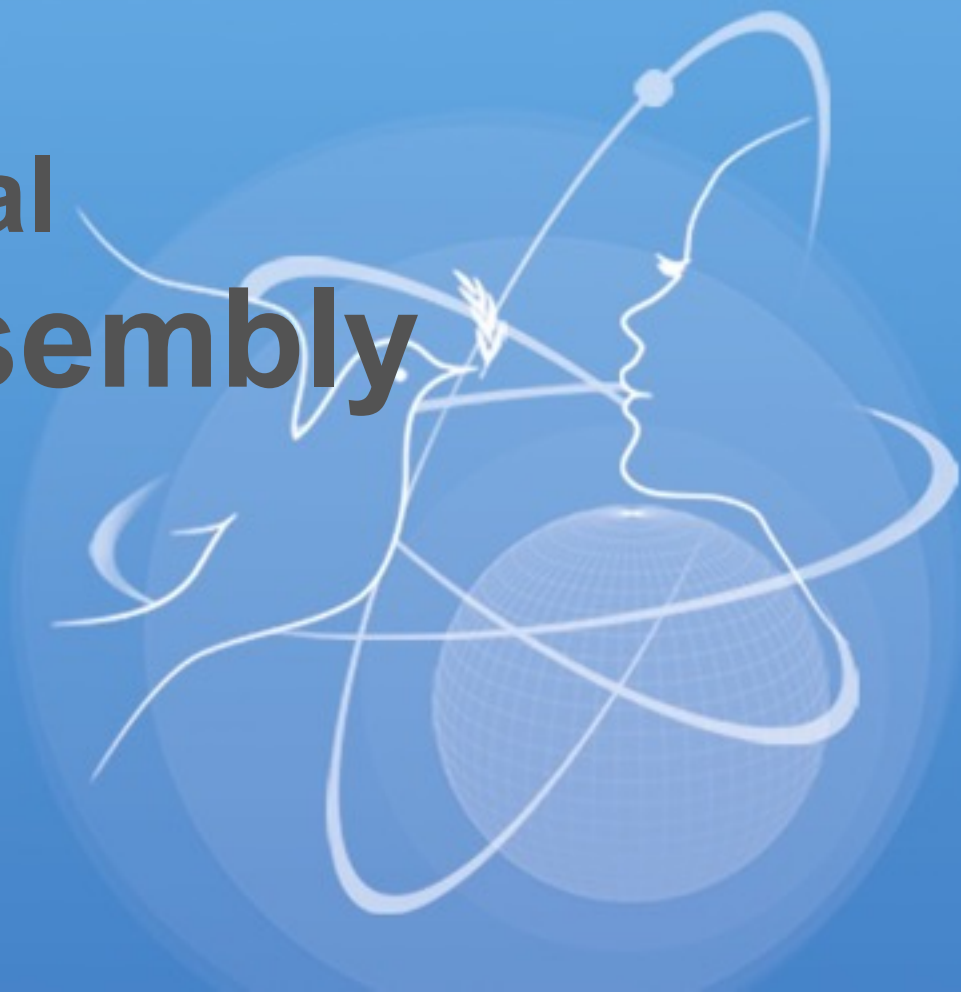

INTRODUCTION

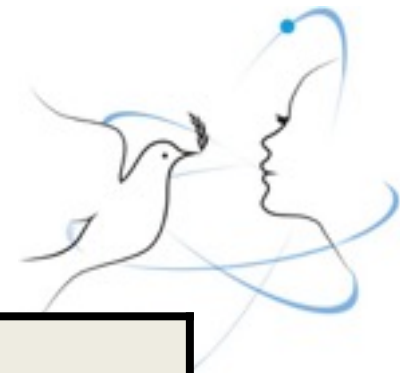

WiN celebrated its 20th anniversary in Johannesburg during the 2013 WiN Global Annual Conference and the book “20 years of WiN” was published to commemorate and recollect the history of Women in Nuclear. 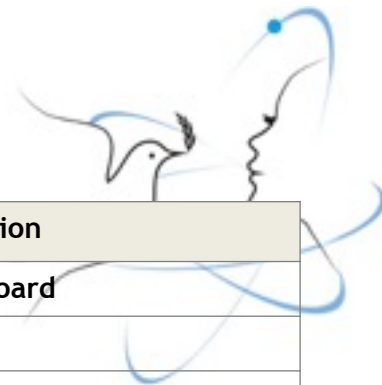

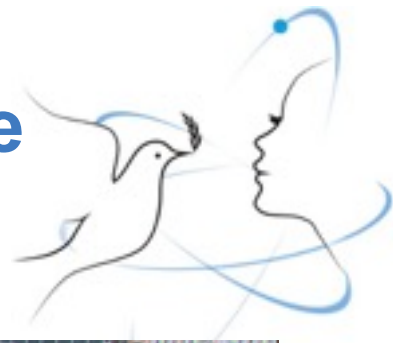

WiN Global Declaration of Nuclear for Climate



- Proposed by Dominique Mouillot (WiN Global Vice-President/WiN Europe President)
- Global movement by one voice of nuclear societies on nuclear for climate with low carbon emission
 - 39 nuclear societies, representing 50,000 scientists from 36 countries of 5 continents on 4th May 2015 jointly signed a declaration against climate change -> increasing 42 Societies
- WiN Global Boards decided to join this movement as part of initiative 'WiN Global Declaration on Nuclear for Climate'
- Working group: Dominique Mouillot, Irene Aegerter, Se-Moon Park, Gabrielle Flannery and Sophie Prevot
