Chapter activities



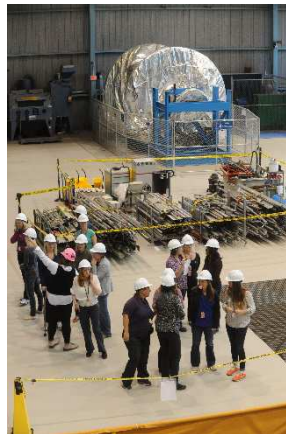
- 10% growth of membership in 2014/2015

Nuclear developments



- Refurbishment of units at Bruce & Darlington
- Decommissioning unit at Pickering
- Low & Intermediate Waste - Ontario Power Generation is in the regulatory approval phase for a deep geologic repository
- Long-term storage of used fuel – Adaptive Phased Management approach chosen by Government in 2007 – currently seeking a willing host community
- Cameco Corporation announced that it had signed a supply agreement with the Department of Atomic Energy of India to provide 7.1 million pounds of uranium concentrate under a long-term contract through 2020
