Dissemination of National Nuclear-HRD Network for Efficient and Effective N-HRD for NPP-Embarking Countries

Close mutual cooperation among nuclear-related organizations, such as government, industry and academia is extremely useful to promote Nuclear Human Resources Development (HRD). National HRD network has already been established in Japan since Nov. 2010. The network has promoted the following five discussion on (1) Elementary to High School Education (2) Nuclear Education at Universities and Colleges, (3) HRD for Working Engineers, (4) HRD to Internationalize National Human Resources, and (5) Supportive HRD Activities to newly NPP Introducing Countries successfully.
